A ROUNDTABLE DISCUSSION ON THE TOPIC
"UZBEKISTAN'S WTO MEMBERSHIP: SPECIAL AND
PREFERENTIAL REGIME IN AGRICULTURE"

On November 30, 2023, UWED hosted a round table on "Uzbekistan's accession to the WTO: special and preferential regime in agriculture". The benefits challenges for Uzbekistan's and agricultural sector in connection with WTO accession were discussed, including market access and policy changes. Particular attention was paid to the opportunities provided by preferential regimes for sustainable agricultural development, which can contribute to the country's food security.





EVENTS AND PROJECTS IN 2023 FOR ENSURING FOOD SECURITY

On September 11, 2023, UWED hosted the international conference "Uzbekistan's Path to WTO Accession". The event was aimed at discussing regulatory reforms, economic benefits and challenges for agriculture and industry upon accession to the WTO. Particular attention was paid to market access and the impact on the agricultural sector, which is potentially related to improving food security.

On September 4, 2023, UWED hosted an international conference on the sustainable development of Central Asia. The dissertation on "Mechanisms of Improving the Production and Export of Fruit and Vegetables in Uzbekistan Corresponding to the World Market Requirements" connected to Sustainable Development Goal 2 (SDG 2), which aims to end hunger, achieve food security, improve nutrition, and promote sustainable agriculture is defeated by the senior teacher of the "International economics" department on 31 May, 2023. By exploring strategies to enhance the production and export of fruit and vegetables, the research addresses key aspects of agricultural productivity and sustainability. This focus on aligning Uzbekistan's agricultural practices with world market standards can help ensure that local farmers adopt efficient, sustainable methods that yield higher-quality produce. As a result, these improvements could reduce food insecurity by increasing the availability of nutritious food both domestically and internationally. Additionally, strengthening export capabilities supports the economic stability of rural communities, which can, in turn, contribute to more resilient food systems and help lift people out of poverty, furthering the goal of ending hunger and promoting sustainable food production.



DOCTORAL RESEARCH ADVANCING ZERO HUNGER SOLUTIONS



On September 14, 2023, Moiliyev Elyor Bakhtiyorovich, on the topic "IMPACT OF UZBEKISTAN'S MEMBERSHIP IN THE WTO ON THE AGRICULTURAL SECTOR" 08.00.09 - took place the department discussion of the dissertation work prepared for receiving the PhD degree in the specialty "World Economy".

The dissertation topic, "Impact of Uzbekistan's Membership in the WTO on the Agricultural Sector" has significant relevance to Sustainable Development Goal 2 (SDG 2), which focuses on ending hunger, achieving food security, improving nutrition, and promoting sustainable agriculture. By examining Uzbekistan's potential WTO membership effects on agriculture, this research provides insights into how international trade policies could shape food security and agricultural sustainability in the country. WTO membership could open Uzbek agricultural markets to global competition, encouraging local farmers to adopt more efficient, sustainable, and competitive farming practices. This integration into the global economy has the potential to enhance the productivity of the agricultural sector, improve the quality and variety of available food, and increase farmers' incomes by expanding export opportunities. Furthermore, access to international agricultural standards and technologies could promote sustainable farming practices, helping to ensure that Uzbekistan's agricultural development aligns with both environmental sustainability and food security goals. Ultimately, this dissertation addresses how WTO membership can support the modernization of Uzbekistan's agricultural sector, contributing directly to the targets of SDG 2 by fostering a resilient, productive, and sustainable food system.



DOCTORAL RESEARCH ADVANCING ZERO HUNGER SOLUTIONS

The implementation actions taken by various government and non-government organizations in Uzbekistan to support the research on "Impact of Uzbekistan's Membership in the WTO on the Agricultural Sector" are directly linked to achieving Sustainable Development Goal 2 (SDG 2) targets, which focus on ending hunger, achieving food security, improving nutrition, and promoting sustainable agriculture. Government bodies such as the Ministry of Agriculture and the Ministry of Investment and Foreign Trade can introduce policies aligned with WTO standards, such as providing subsidies for smallholder farmers, promoting access to international markets, and ensuring compliance with quality and safety standards. These actions help increase productivity, reduce food insecurity, and make nutritious food more accessible and affordable for the population. By implementing these supportive actions, both government and NGO initiatives help Uzbekistan's agricultural sector grow in a sustainable way that aligns with WTO standards, contributing to SDG 2's targets of resilient food production, improved livelihoods for farmers, and a secure food supply for future generations.
